- Improves Communication.

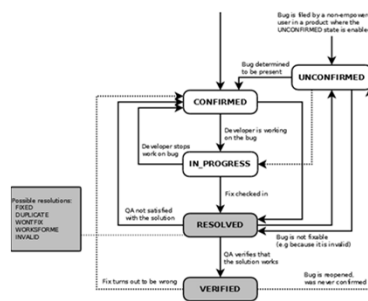

- o Request Id: Number
- o Detailed Description
- o Severity\Priority : - critical, major, minor\p1,p2
- o Category if any, like Gui, Installation or certain module

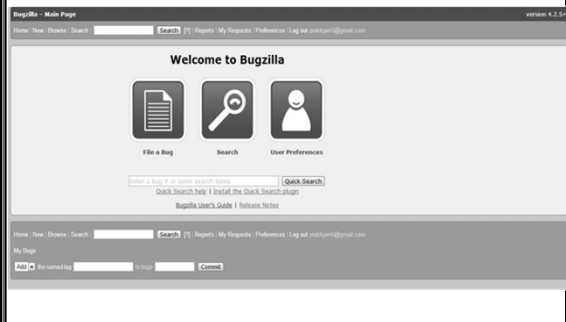
